North Maclean issues remain

A MEETING with Councillor Lynne Clarke has failed to quell residents' concerns about future development at North Maclean.

Under the latest draft South East Queensland Regional Plan, North Maclean is noted as a possible site for a future light industrial estate.

About 10 residents last week met with Cr Clarke and council officers to voice their concerns about the proposal and seek concil's stance on the issue.

Cr Clarke said she could not speak for her colleagues but she was opposed to the proposal, however Cr Phil Pidgeon, also at the meeting, said he believed the area's potential for development should be investigated.

Munruben's Anne Page said the meeting did not instil confidence in those present as it was clear council officers were not aware of key background information about the proposal.
